

SIBLING SEXUAL TRAUMA (SIBLING SEXUAL ABUSE)

Harmful or abusive sexual behaviour between children or young people who share the same home and/or the same parents

1 in 25

Sibling Sexual Trauma

Affects 2-5% of children Happens in all types of families and in all places

IT IS REAL

- Happens between young people of any gender, with any age difference
- Children may think it's mutual, but it's not
- As traumatic as sexual abuse by an adult
- Developmentally inappropriate behaviour
- Usually long-lasting but can be just once

IT IS UNIQUE

- Both are children: often difficult to recognise, even for a child being abused
- Young people who cause sexual harm need treatment and supervision, but not all will continue to offend as adults
- A family tragedy: all need support
- Surrounded by stigma and silence
